

Chartus Agency Nov. 20th 1829

Sir

I advised you on the 14th Inst. that I had not then been able to get an answer to your communication of July 31st.

Since my last I have rec^d. the enclosed letter from Col. David Golsom, I was not at home when it came to hand or it would have been forwarded to the Dept. sooner. I have no doubt but the letter alluded to is the hand write of Golsom but the style is different from his usual way of writing. —

Mingo Muckhalubbed has had a great Council and from what I learn there will not be much difficulty ~~in~~ ^{with} a number of Indians removing next year, with proper management.
