Instruct Mr Donelly to appoint a day that the chiefs will be at Franklin—or if they will not come, but give assurances that they will treat, to appoint a day & place in the nation I want the chiefs to come here—Laflour can influence the cherokees, & as soon as we make arrangements with the choctaws by sending Laflour to the cherokees, he can bring a delegation to meet us on our way to Washington in East Tennessee.

I have just recd. a letter from Major Barry, all is well in the Department of War—Having just recd. a letter from Genl Coffee who says he will be at Franklin on the evening of the 28th. I will be there with judge Overton to see him—present me respectfully to your lady, mother & Doctor Brethit & Lady, & excuse the haste in which this is written
