Friend and Brother.



Sir your letter of the 24th of July
has been rec^d we have had it read and interpreted
to us we have appointed a general Council for the
chiefs and head men of the Choctaw Nation to
meet on the 15th Inst to have your ^{by} Communication
sent by Mr. Donnelly read and interpreted when
we will prepare ourselves to go on to meet our
Father the president we intend to go on with
all powers from our Nations to ^{act} and transact
business for the Nation but whither clothed with
full powers ^{or not} we are Determined to go on to see our
Father the president agreeable to his wishes
we shall ^{set} out immediately after our Council
is over we are your friends and Brothers
