Friend and Brother.

Sir your letter of the 24th. of July has been Recd. we have had it Read and Interpreted to us we have appointed a General Council for the Chiefs and head men of the Chocktaw Nation to meet on the 15th. Inst. to have your by Communication sent by Mr. Donnolley Read and Interpreted when we will prepare ourselves to go on to meet our Father the president we Intend to go on with all powers from our Nation to act and Transact business for the Nation but whither Clothed with full powers or not we are Determined to go on to see our Father the president agreable to his wishes we shall set out Immediately after our Council is over we are your friends and Brothers
