Sir

You will learn all the
particulars respecting the Choctaws by
Majr Davly. Should you send commissaries
to hold a Treaty with them, ~~they~~ will
stand in need of some articles from
Vicksburg. I would also recommend
to you to have three or four thousand
pounds of bacon and about ^{up} ~~up~~
of coffee and three of sugar ^{needed} ~~needed~~
up and delivered out to the Indians at
the Treaty. They want the bacon to cook
^{with} their beef. ~~with~~ if you can choose to
give them the above mentioned articles
I will have them on the Treaty
ground by having a few days notice
and will furnish the beef at three
cents per pound. You must order the
Treaty to be held at or near My
Millary, on the Robinson road.

It will be all important that
Major Eaton should attend the Treaty.
I hope you will move by
your acts that you are the
true friends of the Choctaws
Major Dabry can inform you what
is needed to satisfy them on this
point.
