Being about to leave the State of Tennessee for Washington City, & not knowing what business may arise with the Choctaws & Chickasaw Indians in my absence, I do hereby appoint & authorise you to arrange not only what has been confided to you by; but any other business which said tribes may desire to transact, you are authorised to arrange & settle fully, & make report of the same
